

New Sub-Category for Coronavirus (COVID-19)



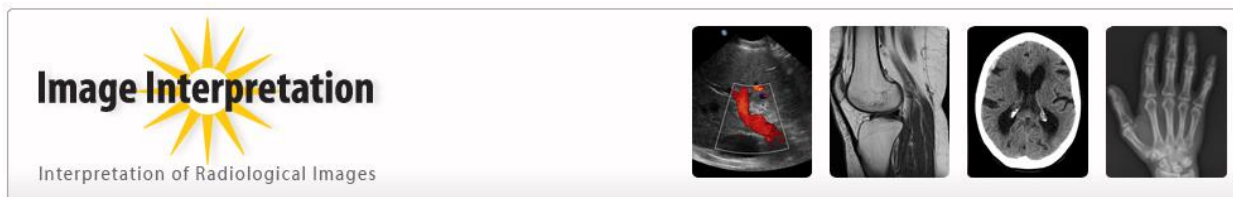
