SUBJECT

Updates to SCORM adapter files have been made and these are now available.

DETAIL

Updated SCORM adapters are now available which will resolve two issues that are detailed in RN467 Release 49.0.0.0, PRB2001635 and PRB2000280.

ACTION REQUIRED

Where a locally hosted e-Learning content server is used in ESR, organisations will need to update their existing SCORM adapter files.

Non JRE SCORM Adapters

The non-JRE updated adapters and further support is available here: https://my.esr.nhs.uk/dashboard/web/esrweb/e-learning-technical-information in the SCORM Adapter section.

Organisations are asked to overwrite existing adapters with the new adapters in the same location using the same file name as the existing adapters – meaning the changes will apply immediately and no further action will be required.

JRE SCORM adapters

It is strongly recommended that any organisations who are still using the JRE SCORM adapter investigate the feasibility of moving to the Non JRE SCORM adapter.

The requirements for a content server to use the Non JRE SCORM adapter are available here: https://my.esr.nhs.uk/dashboard/web/esrweb/e-learning-technical-information

If it is not possible for an organisation to install a Non JRE SCORM adapter, then they are asked to raise an SR to request the updated JRE SCORM adapter files.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Organisations who use the PHP version of the SCORM adapter must update their adapter before midnight on Sunday 28th March.

Organisations who use the ASP version of the SCORM adapter can continue to use the existing adapter but if their content experiences the issues referenced above then these will not be resolved until the SCORM adapters are updated.

Please note that all SCORM adapters for national e-Learning content servers will be updated and no further local action is required. This includes content hosted by NHS Wales, HEE North and HEE South.

NEXT UPDATE

No further update is required.
