DETAIL

In line with Doctors & Dentists Training Contracts, Dental trainees at ST4 and ST5 will be transferring to Nodal Point 5 with effect from 1st April 2023. This change will be applied to ESR in Release 57.4 over the weekend commencing 30th June 2023.
