#### 2 Update Bank Account Details on the Internet

Following the introduction of Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and the additional security it applies to user accounts, it is now possible for users to update their bank details on the Internet where they have registered for MFA.


#### **Employee Self Service**

#### My ESR - My Bank Account Details

When logging in to ESR on the Internet and after entering the code from the Authenticator app, the user will be able to update their bank account details in the same way as they can on HSCN.


Where a user has selected the 'Remember Device' checkbox option as part of MFA login process, they will not be able to update their bank account details until they have entered a code from the Authenticator app.

In this scenario a new message advising users of their next steps will be displayed on the My Bank Account Details portlet as below:


If the user wants to update their bank account details, then they must select the "Upgrade Access" button in the global header bar and enter the code from Microsoft Authenticator App.

In this scenario a message advising the user of their next steps will be displayed on the My Bank Account Details portlet as below:







Where a user has not enabled MFA for their account then they will not be able to update their bank account details until they have registered for MFA on HCSN.

In this scenario a new message advising the user of their next steps will be displayed on the My Bank Account Details portlet as below:



 Please review your bank account details. If you wish to update your details, please register to use Multifactor Authentication by logging into ESR on a device that is connected to the NHS Network. If you are unable to do this and your bank account details are incorrect you should liaise with your new employer once your employment has commenced to ensure that the correct details are held.

**NOTE:** Applicants will not be able to edit bank account details unless an Inter Authority Transfer (IAT) has been initiated for their record.

The 'Reason for Opt Out' list of values on the 'Pension NHS' element has been updated to include 'Partial Retirement 2nd Assignment'.

#### **HMRC Advisory Fuel Rates for 01-SEPTEMBER-2024** 9

HMRC has published new advisory fuel rates for company cars effective 01 September 2024 and these rates are now in use in ESR.

For one month from the date of change, employers may use either the previous or new current rates, as they choose. Employers may therefore make or require supplementary payments if they so wish but are under no obligation to do either.

#### The revised rates are as follows:

Engine Size	Petrol	LPG
1400cc or less	13p	*11p
1401cc to 2000cc	15p	*13p
Over 2000cc	24p	*21p

Engine Size	Diesel
1600cc or less	12p
1601cc to 2000cc	14p
Over 2000cc	18p

Engine Size	Electric
1400cc or less	7p
Over 1400cc	7p
